

SUBJECT: Adjustments in Food Service License Fees

Section 3119 (5) of the Michigan Food Law 2000 states "The department shall adjust on an annual basis the fees prescribed by subsection (1) and (2), as adjusted after November 8, 2000, by an amount determined by the state treasurer to reflect the cumulative annual percentage change in the Detroit consumer price index but not to exceed 5%". Adjustments are to be rounded to the nearest dollar. The absolute value is carried over and used to calculate the next adjustment.

On July 18, 2005, the state treasurer advised that the change in the Detroit consumer price index between June 2004 and June 2005 is 2.0%. The following state fees will apply for food service licenses issued for the 2006/07 licensing period. This information is being provided to you at this time to help plan for the increase.

**Charitable, religious, fraternal, service, civic or other non-profit organizations.

Individuals who have a Veteran's license issued under the authority of Act 359, PA 1921 by the County Clerk are exempt from paying the state fees under section 3119 for food service establishments, mobile food service establishments, mobile food commissary, vending machine locations, temporary food service establishments, and special transitory food units. Veterans are required to pay consumer and education fees and local fees (i.e. local license and plan review fees). Veterans operating special transitory food units are also required to pay for two \$90.00 inspections.
