SUBJECT: Updated Criteria for Reducing the Frequency of Inspection

Attached is a copy of the "Criteria for Reducing the Frequency of Inspection" updated for the Michigan Food Law of 2000. The substantive aspects of the criteria have not been changed. The document is only updated to reflect changes in citations.

Please note: reduced frequency plans approved under the 1976 code should be reviewed to ensure consistency with the Michigan Food Law of 2000. In particular, plans based upon a 100-point inspection score or manager certification will require revision, since the 100-point score will be eliminated, and all establishments must comply with the manager knowledge requirement.
