SUBJECT: **State Surcharge Adjustments in 2002 Food Service Licenses**

The state fee surcharge for food service establishment licenses will be adjusted in 2002 based upon the 2.9 percent Detroit Consumer Price Index increase reported by the Michigan Department of Treasury. The amounts of the projected adjustments listed below are rounded as established under § 3119(5) of the Food Law of 2000.
